

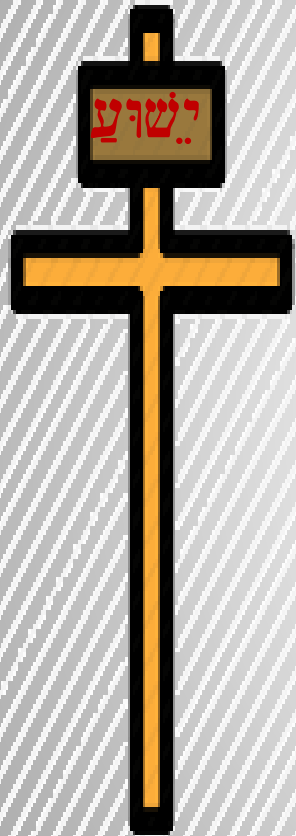

I. Foreshadowing of Perfection through the Law (vv.1-4)

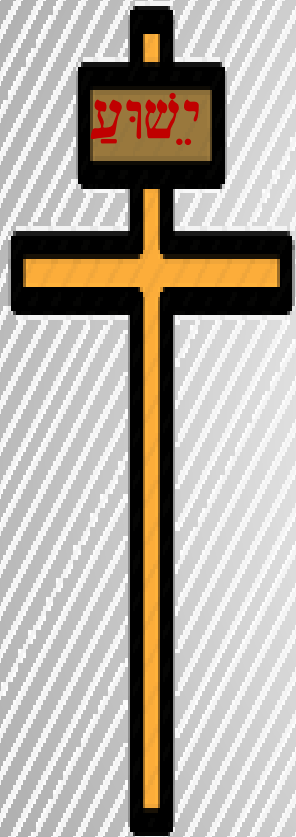
A. Inability of annual animal sacrifices to perfect people for access to God (v.1).

B. Continuation as evidence of its failure to cleanse the guilt of sin (v.2).

C. Annual reminder of sin and sins consequences (v.3).

D. Inability of the blood of animals to annul sin (v.4).

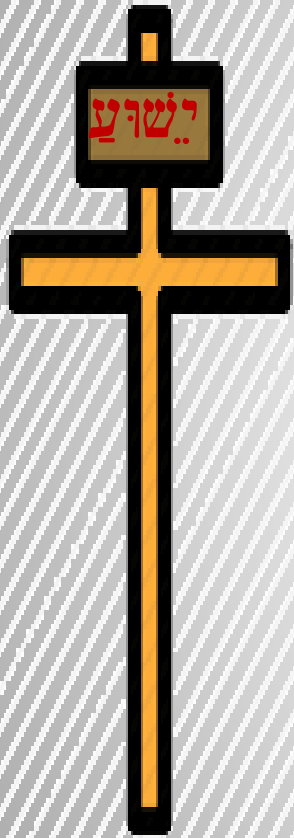
II. Replacement of the Law's Offering by Jesus' Sacrifice (vv.5-10)

A. Jesus' declaration about the purpose of His Incarnation (Ps. 40-6-8) (vv.5-7).

B. His abolition of animal sacrifices for sins by His perfect sacrifice (vv.8-9a).

C. Sanctification of the congregation by His bodily offering (vv.9b-10).

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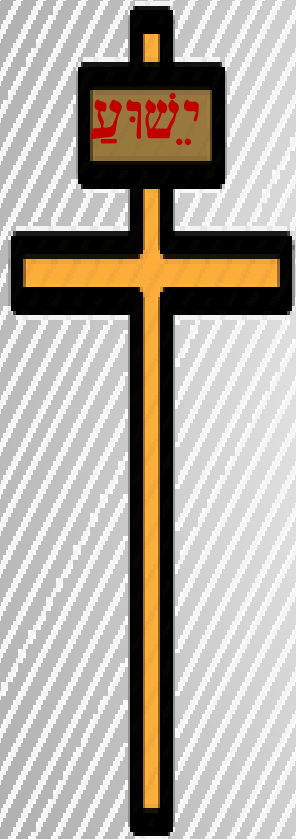

Inability of the Law's Daily Sacrifices to Remove Sins

This verse is a repetition of verses 1-4 in order to re-emphasize that the high priest could never do what Jesus Christ has done!

+ Note that “never” is an **emphatic in Greek**: οὐδέποτε – literally, not even at any time!

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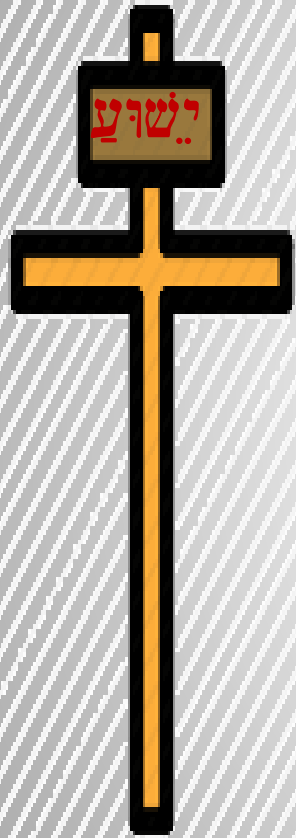

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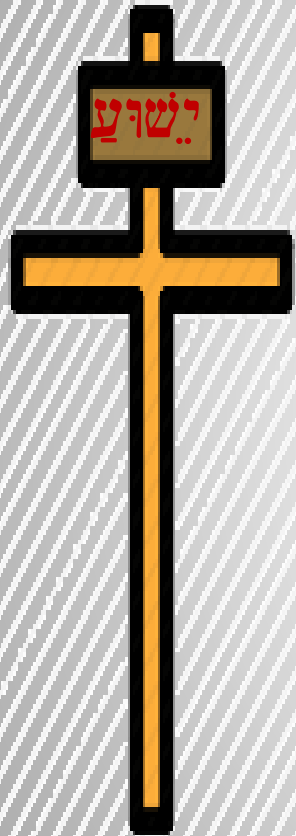

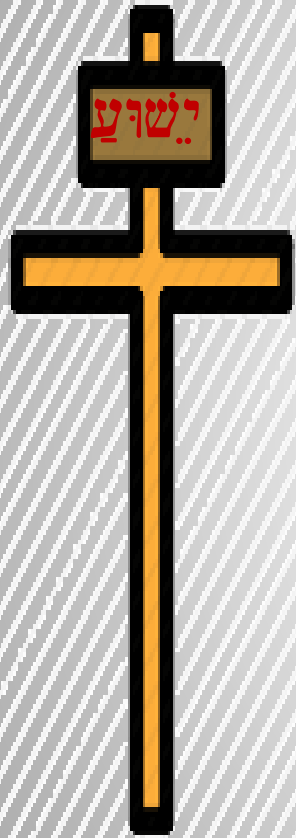

Service of the King/Priest

The King

Amnesty from the debt of sin (v.18);

Defeats our enemies by His death and resurrection (2:14);

We can now come into His presence... and live (4:16)!

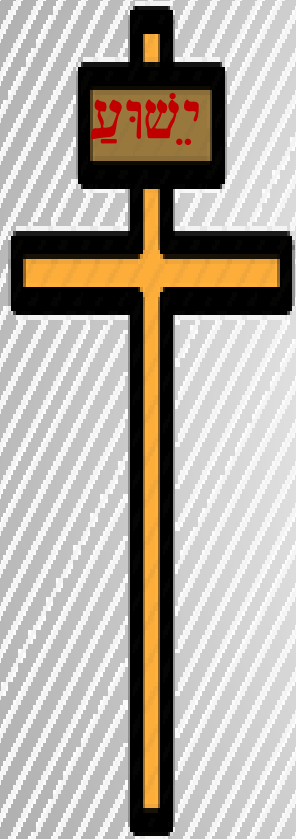
High Priest

Atones for all sin(2:17);

Appears in the presence of the Father in our behalf for our salvation (9:24);

Intercedes for sinners (7:24,25)!

Jesus, as the enthroned
King/Priest now awaits the time
when...

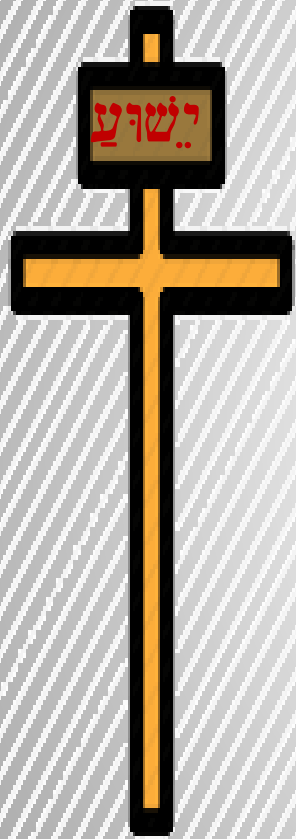


The Greek word for “FOOTSTOOL” is:

ὑποπόδιον

A footstool used by a conquering king, to *place his foot on the neck of the conquered* – i.e., those under His *total dominion*.

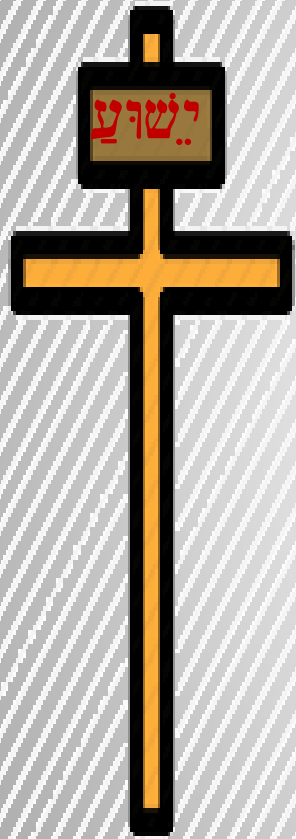
Concluding Argument

“For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.”

Quite surprisingly, Jesus has come to power, not by force, but by His Self-sacrifice!

Thus, He empowers you to reign with Him, spiritually, not politically!

Concluding Argument

Verse 15 is from Jer. 31:31-34 which we discussed in Heb. 8:8-12. But only the part which gives you an amazing promise:

- + God will never remember you sins any longer!!!
- + Your due punishment has been removed from you.

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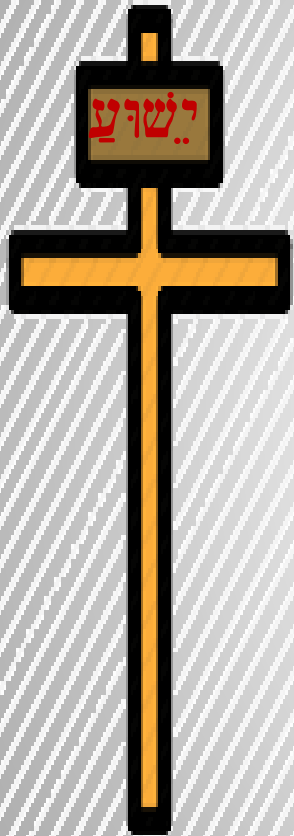
Concluding Argument
