### INTRODUCTION

These final verses of Hebrews 6 encourages us to have HOPE! The Preacher teaches this through four images:

- 1. INHERITANCE: The legality of an oath;
- 2. REFUGEES WITH GOD: We seek refuge with God in His heavenly sanctuary;
- 3. THE HIGH PRIEST OF ISRAEL: The congregation is compared to their actions and those of the High Priest; and,
- 4. THE ANCHORED SHIP: The congregation's hope is anchored, firmly, to God's oath/promise

Verses 18b-20 are a bridge to the rest of the sermon as the preacher will describe the order of his sermon:


The Nation Promise (12:2)

### GOD'S PROMISE TO MBRAHAM

The LORD establishes His promise by taking an oath!

- Swearing by a greater one!
  - \*A ruler, elder, authority figure
- None greater than YHWH
  - \* He swears on Himself!

# GOD'S PROMISE TO ABRAHAM'S HEIRS vv.16-20

#### **Human Inheritance (v.16)**

- + The ancient world was an oral tradition world...oath taking was vital!
- + An oath was legally binding
- + Also legal confirmation
- + Provided certainty



God's Oath

He has no need to confirm His promises with an oath!

- + His promises reliable!
- + His Word is ALWAYS true!
- + Provided certainty



God's Oath
Yet, He gives an oath anyhow,
why!

- + Proves His oath is a greater attestation than a human oath!
- + Delivers a Divine certainty to His heirs no dispute!
- + An unchangeable oath!




God's Purpose (v.18)

- + A double measure
- + Two unchangeable things...
  - + Unchangeable Oath
  - + Unchangeable Promise
- + So the heirs can take refuge in His Oath/Promise



### The Heir's Hope (v.19)

- + Certain and Confirmed
- + Compared to an anchor
  - + Eph 4:14
- + Allusion to entering "the inner place of the curtain"

Jesus' Entry (v.20)

- + To make Atomement for all
- + He is your 66 forerunner 99
  - + πρόδρομος "Trailblazer"
- + As your "forerunner" He has gained access to the Heavenly Holy of Holies...for you; yet, you can only enter through/by Him!


