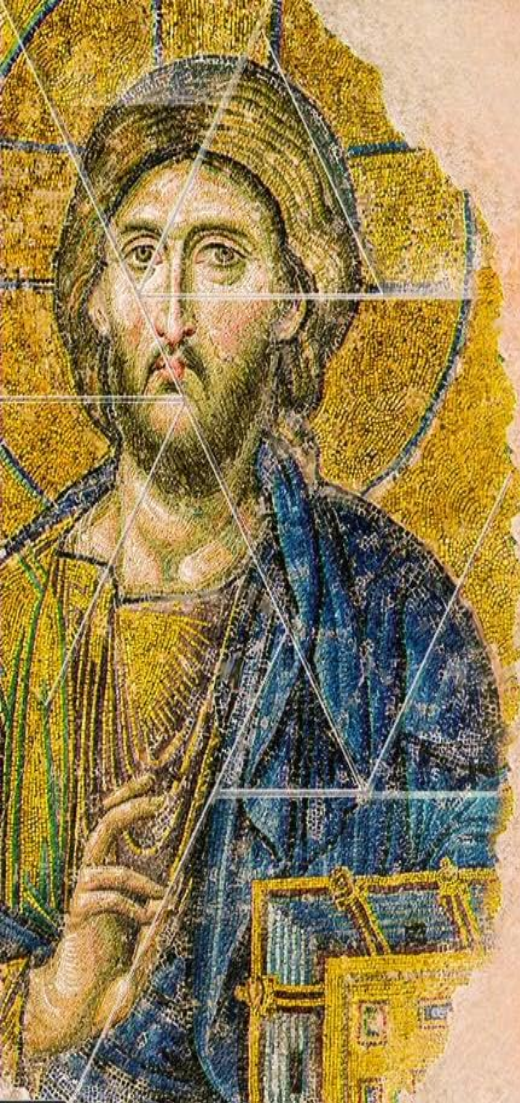


Jesus, the Mediator of the New Covenant

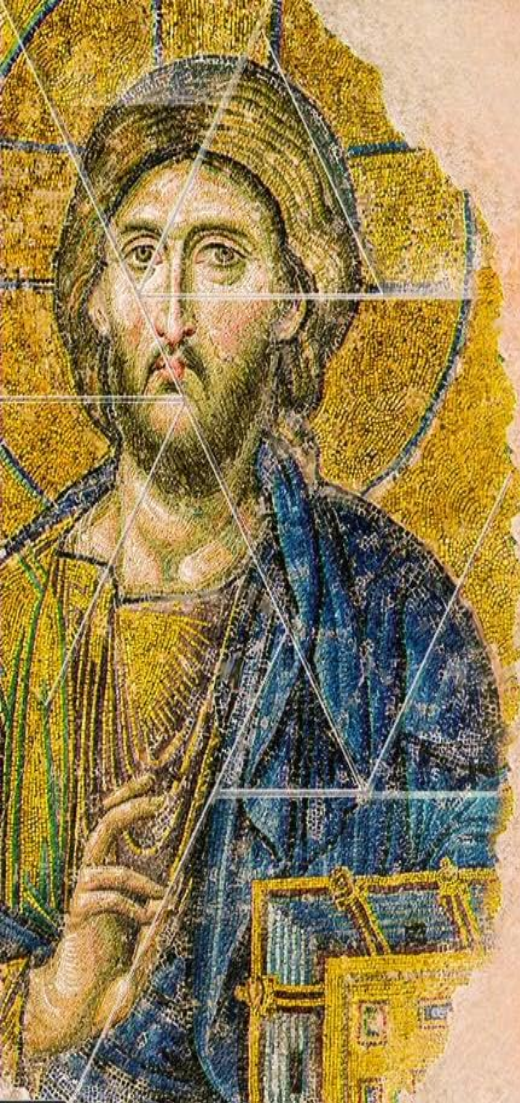

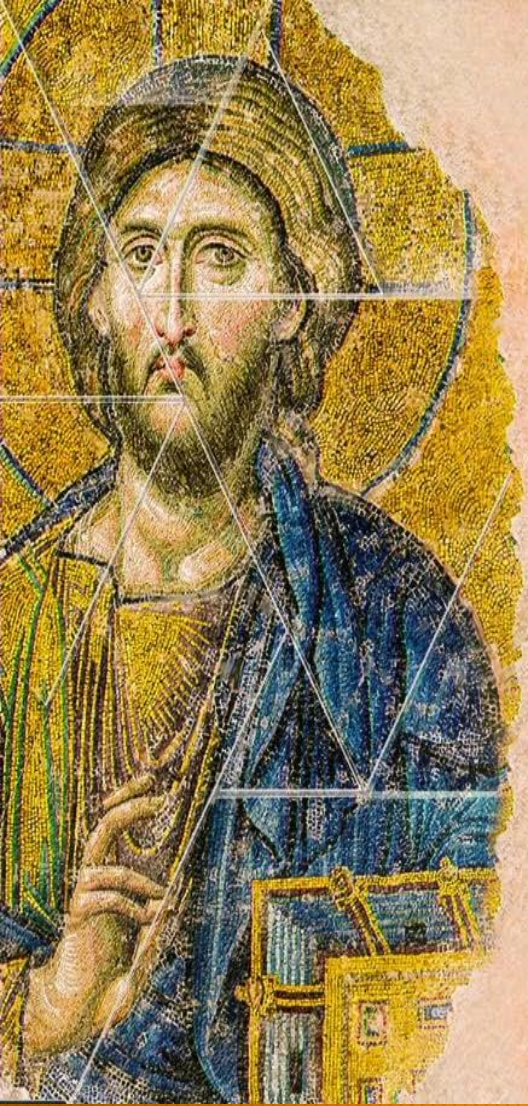

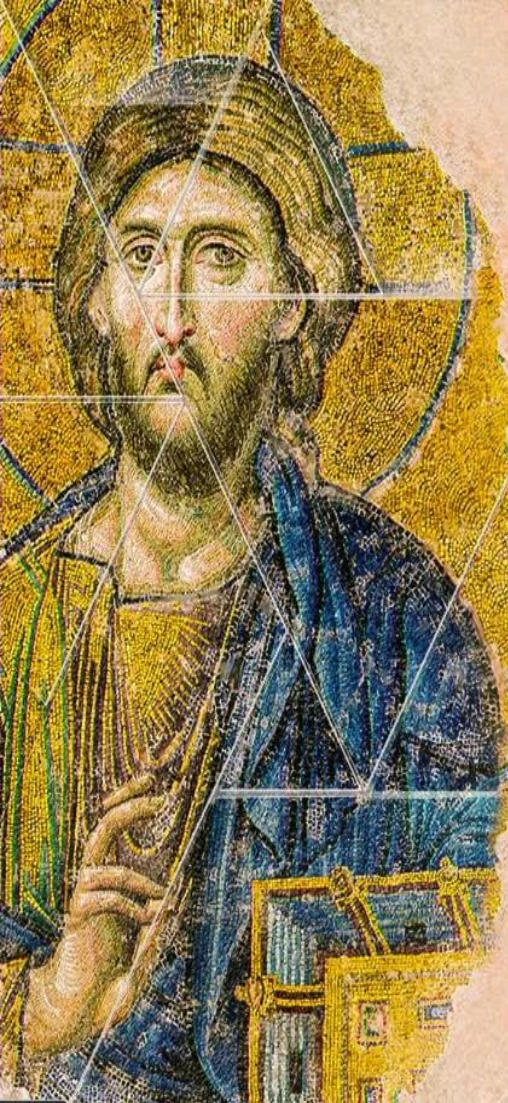


Hebrews 8:6

So, Jesus' ministry is a more excellent ministry.

- He is more excellent than the Levitical priest;**
- Just as His Name is more excellent than the angels (1:4).**

You are righteous! (2 Co 5:21)

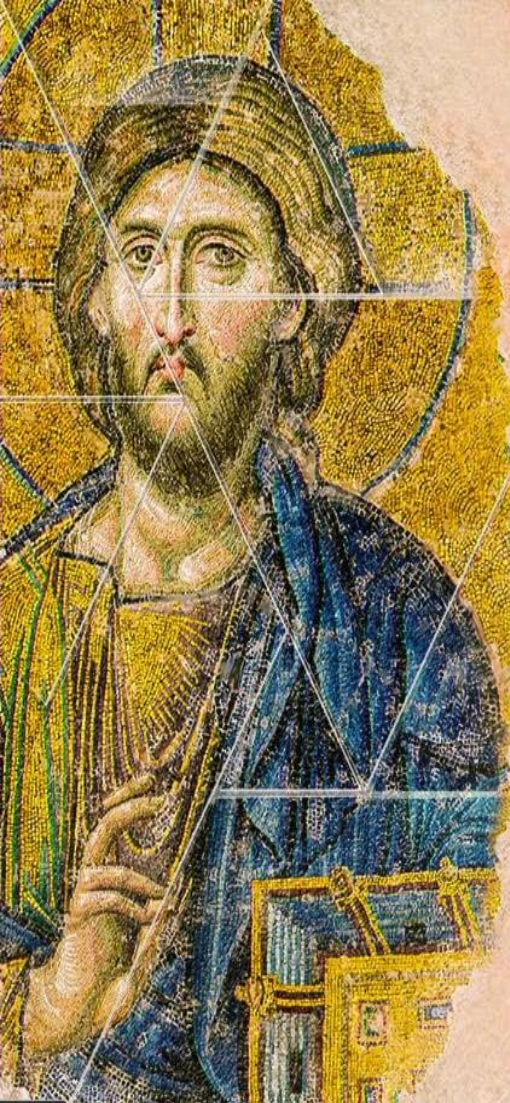
You are holy! (Heb 10:10)

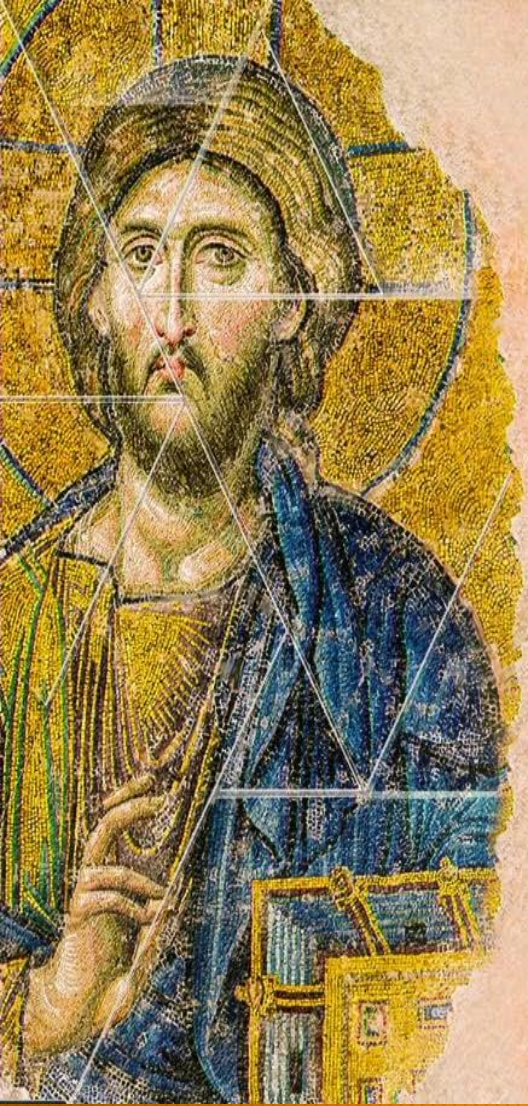

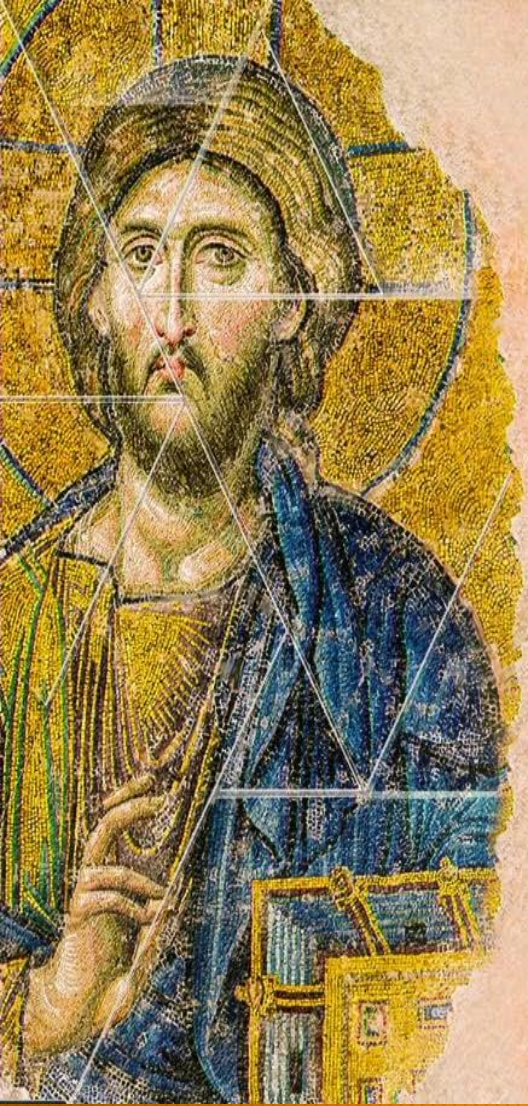

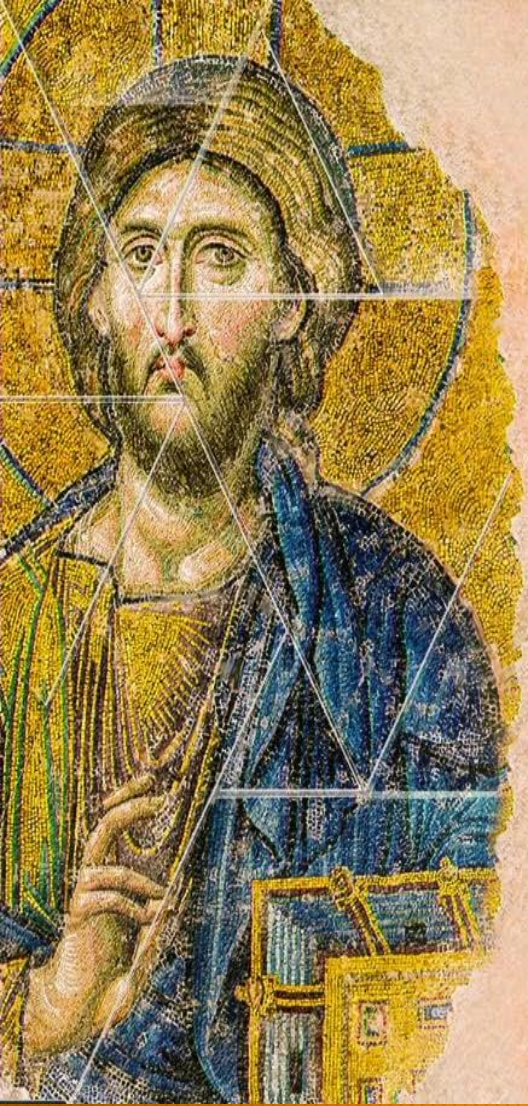
JESUS, MEDIATOR OF THE NEW COVENANT



Hebrews 8:8-12

What we are hearing in vv.8-12 is Divine Speech! Notice the “He says” (v.8a) and then, “says the Lord” three times (vv.8b, 9, 10)

JESUS, MEDIATOR OF THE NEW COVENANT

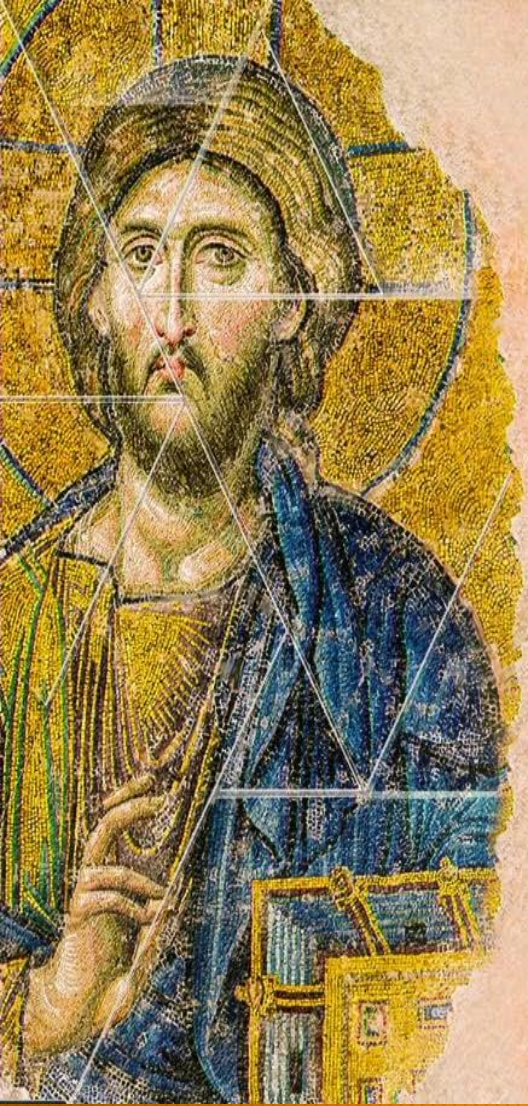


Hebrews 8:8-12

This prophecy locates the New Covenant and the ministry of Jesus Christ!

There are four important points:...

JESUS, MEDIATOR OF THE NEW COVENANT

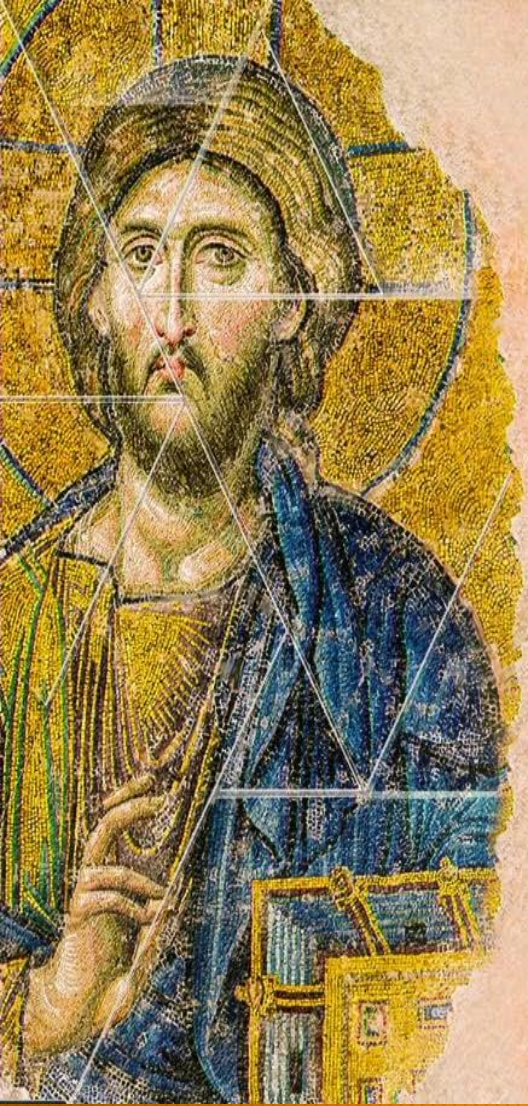


Hebrews 8:8-12

Point #1: *God's New Covenant will be in the age to come;*

Point #2: *It will be different from the Old, which Israel abandoned;*

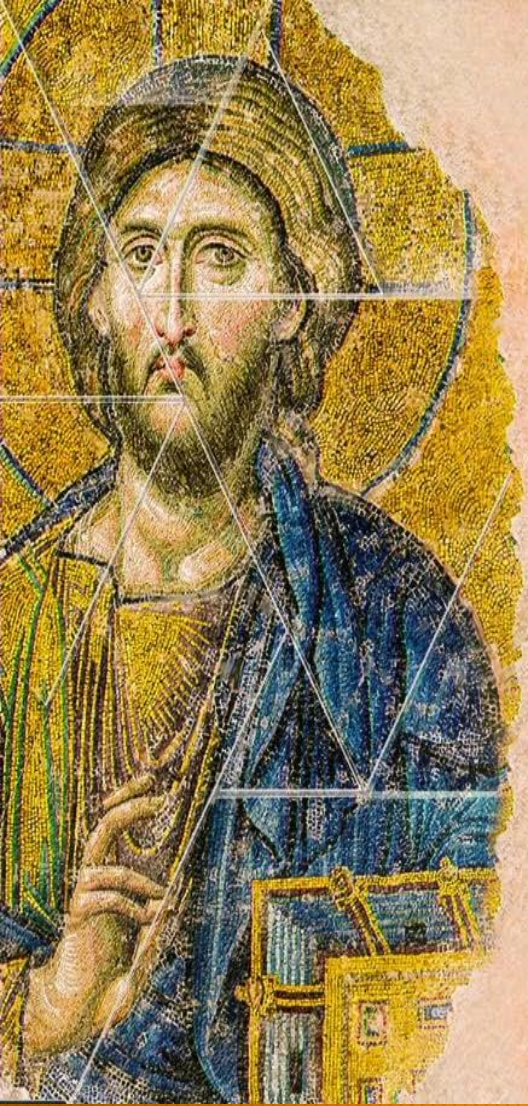
JESUS, MEDIATOR OF THE NEW COVENANT



Hebrews 8:8-12

Point #3: *It will be by God's provision, to instruct their hearts, which results in knowledge of Him; so that they will be His people.*

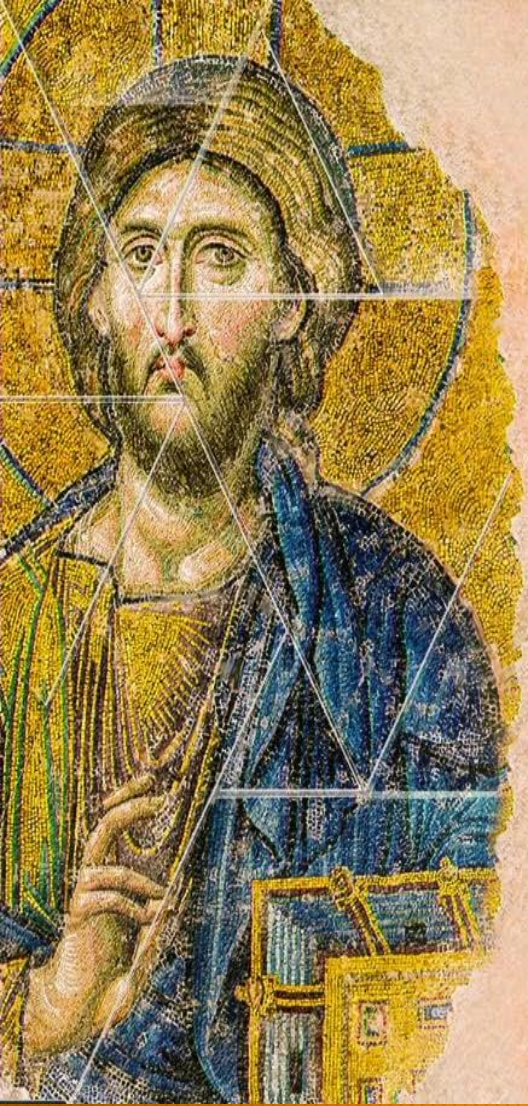
JESUS, MEDIATOR OF THE NEW COVENANT



Hebrews 8:8-12

Point #4: *The basis of the New Covenant is God's mercifulness in His "disremembering" of their sins because their guilt has been dealt with by its removal, forever (v.12).*

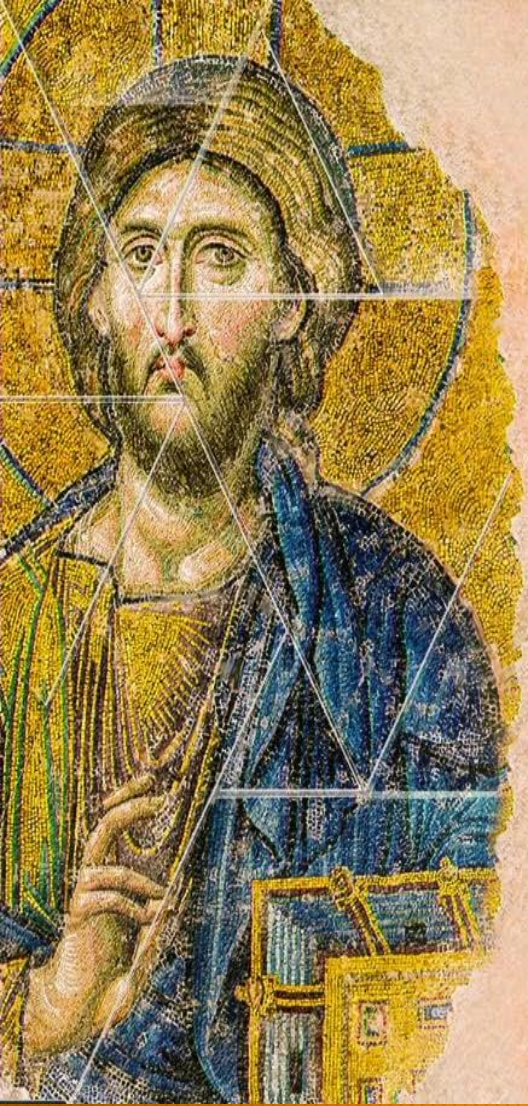
The Final Observation:

**The prophecy has been fulfilled
by Jesus Christ!**

**What God would do...Jesus has
done!**

**Therefore, the Old is now
obsolete...it has been fulfilled!**
