



Blood Bought Inheritance

"WHEREFORE, NEITHER THE FIRST, APART FROM BLOOD, HAS BEEN INAUGURATED."

- + This is the first use of the Greek word: egkainizo (ἐγκαινίζω) to initiate or consecrate.
- + This verse signals a transition from talking about death to discussing the necessity of Blood.



The Inaugural Consecration


- 1. Moses spoke God's Word to all.
- 2. Moses took blood & the Book.
- 3. Moses sprinkled all the people with blood.
- 4. Moses sprinkled the tent/furniture.



Blood Bought Inheritance

- A. The Mosaic Covenant was <u>inadequate</u> to atone for sin in the heavenly realm.
- B. The Tabernacle's Holy of Holies was a copy of the heavenly one.
- C. It was necessary for a more permanent, superior sacrifice to <u>satisfy</u> the heavenly requirements.


THREE CONSIDERATIONS AS A RESULT OF OUR LORD'S HISTORICAL APPEARANCE:

- 1. HE OFFERED HIMSELF, ONLY ONCE, TO DEATH?
- 2. BY HIS BLOOD, UPON ENTERING HEAVEN,

 SIN IS REMOVED; THUS HE IS THE PERFECT

 HIGH PRIEST & SACRIFICIAL VICTIM!

Blood Bought Inheritance

WHAT IS THIS END/GOAL OF HISTORY?

- + HIS SACRIFICE WAS TEMPORAL, BUT THE RESULT IS ETERNAL!
- + HIS SACRIFICE ACCOMPLISHED WHAT NO OTHER COULD EVER DO...THE ANNULMENT OF SIN!

Blood Bought Inheritance

WHAT IS THIS END/GOAL OF HISTORY?

- + THIS ANNULMENT OF SIN IS WITHOUT PARALLEL IN THE OLD COVENANT!
- + ADDITIONALLY, HIS SACRIFICE FULFILLS THE PROMISE OF DANIEL 9:24!

PURIFICATION/DELIVERANCE

+ THOSE WHO HAVE BEEN SAVED FROM SIN ARE NOW BEING DELIVERED FROM ITS PENALTY...WHICH IS ETERNAL DEATH!

NOW & LESSON FROM ISAIAH!

+ LET TURN TO IS. 53 AND READ VERSES 3-12.

Blood Bought Inheritance

- 1. JESUS IS THE INNOCENT SERVANT OF THE LORD.
- 2. HIS SACRIFICE, BY THE FATHER'S WILL, WAS A SIN [GUILT]
 OFFERING WHO BORE THE SINS OF THE WORLD

Blood Bought Inheritance

WHO OFFERED THIS PERFECT SACRIFICE?

THE KEY TERM IS:

"...HAVING BEEN

OFFERED..."

(προσενεχθεὶς)



But this is not the "end of the story!"

GOD THE FATHER REVERSED THE ROLES!!! HE OFFERED THE PERFECT SACRIFICE, JESUS, AS A SIN OFFERING TO CLEANSE, ONCE FOR ALL TIME, MANKIND. SO, THE DEATH OF JESUS WAS A VICARIOUS "JUDGMENT" ON HIM (V.27), WHICH RESULTS IN YOUR SALVATION (V.28A)! IS DEATH IS THE FATHER'S GIFT TO YOU!

Re-Appearance

THE HIGH PRIEST "RE-APPEARED" BEFORE THE PEOPLE, AFTER COMING OUT OF THE HOLY OF HOLIES ON THE DAY OF ATONEMENT, AND BLESS THEM.



YET JESUS' GLORIOUS "RE-APPEARANCE" WILL DIFFER FROM HIS FIRST; IN THAT, THERE WILL BE NO SIN [GUILT] OFFERING!



FOR THOSE WHO WERE "EAGERLY WAITING FOR HIM" HE WILL
RELEASE FROM DEATH FOREVER
AND DELIVER THEM INTO HIS
PROMISED INHERITANCE:



BUT FOR THOSE WHO WERE NOT "EAGERLY WAITING FOR HIM" HE WILL DIVINELY JUDGE THEM AS SINNERS (CF. 10:27-31).
