


aka, The Book of Revelation

# THE BACKGROUND AUTHORSHIP AND TIME

Written by John the Apostle who was exiled to the Island of Patmos in 95 A.D. by the Roman Emperor Domitian. On a Lord's Day (Sunday) during his exile on Patmos (1:9, 10), the Lord gave John His Apocalypse.

- + Thus, the actual title of this book is, *The Apocalypse of Jesus Christ* ( jApokavluyiV jlhsou: Cristou:).
  - Apocalypse means...revelation, unveiling or instruction!

#### **PURPOSE**

A book of prophecy of global extent. It reminds believers that the present life, this world, your problems and sufferings are temporary. God will keep His promise and all believers shall spend eternity in the New Heaven and New Earth.

#### INTERPRETATION

Interpretation of Revelation is limited by <u>two</u> factors:

First, God has told us more than we can understand. Most of the book can be understood and that which cannot be understood should simply be believed, just as we believe The Holy Trinity!

Second, trying to understand Revelation, before you really know the rest of Scripture, is like trying to understand the last chapter of an advanced chemistry book without ever having studied chemistry.

For this reason the study of Revelation should only occur after careful study of the Old Testament and the first twenty-six books of the New Testament.



...to understand Revelation is really the key to understanding the entire Bible: Christ is at the center of this book! And Revelation is given to make us wise unto salvation.

As Dr. Louis Brighton wrote, "Revelation reveals and confirms that Christ was prophetically promised and that His incarnation, death, and resurrection happened so that God's creation could be restored to its original glory and righteousness."1
